In the heart of a preserved nature, Céline and Nicolas, passionate winegrowers, have taken over the family estate of CHATEAU D'ORSAN in the north-east of the Gard.

A wine-producing castle since the 13th century, it is its imposing 18th century façade that is represented on our labels. Our commitment to the environment and biodiversity allows us to highlight the quintessence of an exceptional terroir, to offer you a range of wines that have a soul and a signature.

## CHÂTEAU D'ORSAN AOP Côtes du Rhône

A wine of the terroir, which has a soul and a typicity.



### TERROIR AND GRAPE VARIETIES

Vineyard cultivated on sunny hillsides on clay-limestone soil. Selected parcels of GRENACHE, SYRAH and CARIGNAN, 40 years old on average. Yields are controlled.



### WINE MAKING

The grapes are sorted and picked by hand. The grapes are received at the winery by gravity to keep them intact. The whole bunches will ferment and macerate traditionally for 8 to 10 days, allowing the expression of our terroir in the respect of its biodiversity.



### TASTING

Its color is a deep red with purple nuances. Its nose as well as its mouth is fruity with aromas of red fruits, cherry, small black fruits, black currant. Then spices appear, like sweet pepper with a liquorice finish and a touch of minerality. It is a round, full, smooth, well-balanced wine with silky tannins and a nice finish.



### FOOD PAIRING

It will accompany your meals with cold cuts, red meat, white meat, poultry, grilled meat, game, dishes in sauce and then with cheese and a chocolate or red fruit dessert. Ready to drink, this wine can also be kept for a few years in bottle. The serving temperature is around 16-17° C.



It is not uncommon at nightfall to see colonies of "pipistrelles", a species of small bats that nests under the roofs of our cellars alongside our swallows, chickadees among others. Our little wild black bees still have their original hive in front of our wine cellars, gathering flowers in our vineyards and the surrounding nature, thus testifying the respect of our practices.
